

UK Weather Summary – 2016



JANUARY

	Temp = +0.9 Rain = 152 Sun = 80
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Very mild, unsettled with strong winds and rain – Storm Gertrude Fourth wettest January since 1910 especially in Scot & N.Eng 	

FEBRUARY

	Temp = +0.2 Rain = 129 Sun = 122
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Initially unsettled and frequent rain, then more dry & sunny Milder in the South vs. Scot & NI but less sunshine than Midlands 	

MARCH

COLD DRY	Temp = (0.2) Rain = 91 Sun = 115
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A wet & cold start, an unsettled end but dry & settled in between E&W was colder than average despite being generally sunnier 	

APRIL

COLD 	Temp = (0.9) Rain = 112 Sun = 108
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Started with frequent showers & rain, finished with sleet & snow Generally colder & wetter than average but also sunnier 	

MAY

WARM DRY	Temp = +0.9 Rain = 92 Sun = 115
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unsettled start but mainly fine, warm and sunny, some showers Slightly warmer and sunnier than average especially Scot 	

JUNE

WARM	Temp = +0.9 Rain = 139 Sun = 81
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dry settled start replaced by showers and thunderstorms Warmer than average but dullest June on record in SE /Cent Eng 	

JULY

	Temp = +0.2 Rain = 104 Sun = 92
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Breezy & showery start with rain especially in the North & West 17th to 23rd warm & sunnier with 18th to 20th hot, before more rain 	

AUGUST

	Temp = +0.6 Rain = 99 Sun = 110
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Started unsettled, wet & windy especially in the South Followed by high temps in Eng some places as high as 34°C 	

SEPTEMBER

WARM	Temp = +2.0 Rain = 103 Sun = 95
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Changeable start and end to the month including a hot spell in SE 2nd warmest Sep since 2010, dry in the East & wet in the West 	

OCTOBER

WARM DRY	Temp = +0.3 Rain = 38 Sun = 117
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Predominately dry & fine weather with the odd shower 6th driest October since 1910 & sunniest in Scotland since 1929 	

NOVEMBER

COLD FLOODING	Temp = (1.3) Rain = 89 Sun = 130
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some snow in Scot as Storm Angus brought flooding to SW Above average sunshine but below average temperatures 	

DECEMBER

DRY MILD	Temp = +2.0 Rain = 69 Sun = 104
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cold and frosty start to the month but mainly dry and mild 8th warmest December since 1910 above average sunshine
