

UK Weather Summary – 2017



JANUARY

 DRY	Temp = +0.2 Rain = 62 Sun = 120
----------------	---------------------------------------

- Dry, settles & cold to begin with snow in most place 11th to 14th
- Some rain in the south & SE but 10th sunniest Jan since 1929

FEBRUARY

 WINDY MILD	Temp = +1.6 Rain = 103 Sun = 79
-------------------------------------	---------------------------------------

- Mild & unsettled with wet and windy weather – some snow
- Storm Doris on the 23rd saw damaging winds and some snow

MARCH

 DRY MILD	Temp = +1.8 Rain = 104 Sun = 121
-----------------------------------	--

- Started mild but changeable then colder & wet at the end
- Joint warmest March since 1910 with above average sunshine

APRIL

 WARM DRY	Temp = +0.6 Rain = 48 Sun = 109
-----------------------------------	---------------------------------------

- Started warm & dry, becoming colder at the end of the month
- Cloudy but average rainfall & the 10th driest April since 2010

MAY

 WARM	Temp = +1.7 Rain = 83 Sun = 115
-----------------	---------------------------------------

- Quite mixed, some rain & showers but also dry & sunny
- Sunshine above average and 10th sunniest May since 1929

JUNE

 HOT	Temp = +1.5 Rain = 155 Sun = 96
----------------	---------------------------------------

- Significant rainfall but also very hot in 2nd half of the month
- Highest June temp since 1976 but also 6th wettest since 1910

JULY

 WARM	Temp = +0.0 Rain = 137 Sun = 99
-----------------	---------------------------------------

- Generally unsettled, warm in parts but also cooler & wet
- Slightly more rain than on average especially in the SE

AUGUST

 Temp = (0.4) Rain = 117 Sun = 98

- Cloudy with quite a bit of rain, warmer between the 17th & 23rd
- The SE did see some high temps between the 27th & 29th

SEPTEMBER

 Temp = (0.1) Rain = 124 Sun = 88

- Mostly unsettled, especially in England & quite windy
- Average temps, below normal in the South but above in the North

OCTOBER

 WARM	Temp = 1.8 Rain = 79 Sun = 80
-----------------	-------------------------------------

- Often cloudy but warm with some unusually high temps
- Drier than average and it did get colder at the end of the month

NOVEMBER

 DRY FROST	Temp = (0.4) Rain = 89 Sun = 121
------------------------------------	--

- Started quiet although turning much colder in the last week
- Quite sunny in most parts of the country

DECEMBER

 WINDY FROST	Temp = 0.2 Rain = 99 Sun = 115
--------------------------------------	--------------------------------------

- Cold & frosty with snow, especially in the Midlands
- Strong winds at the beginning and end of the month
