London Mayor on Asian tour to promote that the capital is still open for business...

Sadiq Khan has announced a landmark trade visit to the Asian subcontinent to promote London. The Mayor, whose parents immigrated to London from Pakistan, will be visiting six cities in six days across Pakistan and India later this year. During his tour, he will visit Mumbai, Amritsar and Delhi in India, as well as Lahore, Islamabad and Karachi in Pakistan, in a bid to enhance economic and cultural ties with London.

Heathrow Airport has become the latest large employer and first airport in the UK to offer its lowest paid employees the living wage. As part of its "Heathrow 2.0" sustainability strategy, the airport has agreed to pay all its employees at least the London Living Wage, which was increased on Monday (November 6) to £10.20 an hour.
