QUARTER 2 - 2023




Beer sales in Pubs, Bars & Restaurants were up +1.2% in Q2 2023, taking the MAT to +1.7% –comparisons vs last year are starting to be normalize.

Quarter 2 +1.2%

MAT Q2 +1.7%

- ➤ Beer sales in the **on-trade** were **up +1.2%** in **Q2 2023**, this follows a growth of +0.2% in Q1 2023
 - This compares to a growth of +28.8% in Q2 last year
- This means the MAT is currently growing by +1.7%
 - Compares to a MAT growth of +94.4% this time last year
- The on-trade is currently 11.10M brls, which is 41.2% of all beer sales on a MAT basis



<u>Update</u> Q2 2023 – 31st August 2023




Beer sales in Supermarkets, Convenience Stores & Off-Licenses were up +0.2% in Q2 2023, taking the MAT to (1.7%), as MAT sales continue to lap lockdown levels.

Quarter 2 +0.2%

MAT Q2

- ▶ Beer sales in the off-trade were up +0.2% in Q2 2023, this follows a growth of +2.3% in Q1 2023
 - This compares to a decline of (15.4%) in Q2 last year
- This means the MAT is currently declining at a rate of (1.7%)
 - This compares to a MAT of (12.8%) this time last year
- The off-trade is currently 15.81M brls, which is 58.8% of all beer sales on a MAT basis




Total beer sales were up +06% in Q2 2023, with the MAT in decline of (0.3%), driven by lower sales in the off-trade.

Quarter 2 +0.6%

MAT Q2 (0.3%)

- ➤ Total beer sales grew in Q2 2023 by +0.6% this follows a growth of +1.3% in Q1 2023
 - This compares to a decline of (1.6%) in Q2 last year
- This means the MAT is currently in decline at a rate of (0.3%)
 - This compares to a MAT which was up +12.2% this time last vear
- The total UK beer market is currently 26.91M brls, about (83th) brls less than it was at this time last year
